When I meet a class for the first time, I always introduce myself and ask the students to tell me their names. Then we ask each other questions. Usually the conversation is about hobbies, favorite kinds of food or music, and family. Sometimes, however, students' questions are really unusual.

The first thing Mariko asked me was, “(①)” I told her I was Type A and she looked (I). Mariko said, “(②) That's because you are a funny, happy type of guy. You are definitely a B.”

I tried to explain that I saw the doctor and received a certificate that said I had Type A+ blood. But she persisted. “Maybe the doctor made a mistake,” Mariko said. “(③) So, I am sure you're Type B.” I couldn't convince Mariko that she was wrong. Eventually, we decided that I might be a Type B personality in a Type A body.

In England, people don't ask each other about their blood types. Nobody would select a boyfriend, girlfriend, or company worker based on ④such a thing. Most English people may say that blood type had (II) relevance to their lives outside of the hospital emergency room.

But then, two American authors wrote bestselling books that said people should eat foods that are “right for their type,” and things changed a bit. These authors said our blood types are connected to our genetics, and ⑤this determines the amount of different types of food we need to eat. Thus, while most Americans don't believe that blood type influences personality, many believe it determines the kinds of vegetables they should have on their dinner plates.

Personally, I am not convinced. I pay no attention to my astrological star sign or the animal coinciding with the year of my birth on the Chinese calendar. I don't study the lines on my palms or the tea leaves in my cup. Mariko might think I make “things to do” lists because I have Type A blood, but maybe ⑥it is just because I am busy and usually forget things.

So, although my students may continue to ask my blood type, I will keep asking them their favorite movies, music and flavors of ice cream.
